The Inter-Community Business Licence term is the same as the Municipal Business Licence term of one year from January 1st to December 31st.

Business must comply with all of the Bylaws and Regulations within each of the participating municipalities in which it operates.

Business is service oriented (i.e. focus is on providing labour or an intangible benefit to its clients).
